Call for Papers

We are pleased to invite proposals for lectures to be given at the Art Medal World Congress FIDEM XXXI. All the lectures will be given at the Tampere Hall congress centre.

As usual, proposals are invited on all aspects of medallic art, both historical and contemporary. A suggested theme to which lecturers are now invited to contribute is the teaching of medallic art. In the historical context, subjects might include the organisation of artists' studios, apprenticeships, academies and other methods of training. In the contemporary field, examples of best practice in teaching and innovative ways of introducing artists to medallic work would be welcome.

Papers may be given in English or French. All submissions should be sent by e-mail using PDF or Microsoft Word format documents. It is assumed that presentations will be given by PowerPoint. The length of each lecture is about 20 minutes, after which there is some time for discussion. There will be two lecture sessions running at the same time in two separate lecture rooms.

The deadline for your proposals is January 31, 2010.

The papers should include:

- the title of the proposed paper
- the author's name and full contact information
- a brief abstract of max 250 words.

Please send your proposals to **presiden@fidem-medals.org**. The organising committee will choose the lectures and send invitations to the selected lecturers in due course.
